



New Code - LL#75 and LL#112 CO & Smoke Alarms



CO & Smoke Alarms New Code Requirement - Effective April 1, 2014

- Sealed-In Lithium Battery**
Must be Sealed-In, Non-Removal/Replaceable Battery with 10 Year Battery Life of the alarm and UL 217 compliant.
- End of Life Warning**
Alarm must have an audible end of life alert and must be UL 2034 compliant.
- Tamper Resist**
(When activated upon installation) Alarm must be effective in preventing someone from removing the unit from mounting bracket.
- Self Activation**
Alarm must automatically activate when attached to the mounting bracket.
- Hard Wired or Battery Operated**
CO and Smoke Alarms can be either hard wired or battery operated as long as the above new codes are met.



Our Recommendation:

If you can't remember the last time you addressed the buildings CO or Smoke Alarm situations, chances are your current CO and Smoke Alarms have already expired. Most older models only have a life span of five years. To avoid fines and liability, we recommend considering a building wide CO and Smoke Alarm replacement.
